

Three Fires Council Polar Bear Campout

For Troops and Crews!

(Not available to Cub Scouts – according to BSA Policy; Cub Scouts (including Webelos) may not camp in tents in these winter conditions)

To qualify for the POLAR BEAR Award, the unit or individual must complete the following requirements:

1. The campout must take place between November 1st and March 31st.
2. Unit must provide appropriate training for cold weather camping prior to campout.
3. Camping must take place under canvas or an improvised shelter (NO CABINS).
4. All meals must be cooked over a wood or charcoal fire.
5. Duration of camp stay must be 24 hours or more.
6. Temperature must reach 32 degrees or lower during the campout period.
7. For all this wonderful fun, they earn the POLAR BEAR patch, which may be purchased at either the Norris or Deicke Scout Shops.
