

Reporting Eagle Palms

Eagle Palms are reported on the Advancement Report form (34403). The eagle palm application (58-709) has been discontinued. Eagle palms awarded at the completion of an Eagle Board of Review should be reported on the same advancement form used to report the eagle.

Should the palms be missed at the Eagle Board of Review, the eagle, scoutmaster and committee chair will be notified by the BSA via email.

Subsequent palms may be reported on an advancement report. No Board of Review signatures or other attachments are required.

The palm appliances should be purchased when the Advancement Report is submitted. In the case of multiple palms being awarded, the unit may decide to purchase only the appliances for the highest number of palms earned. This could be the case where the scout has turned 18 and can earn no more palms. At most one bronze or gold palm may be worn on the eagle badge:

46	25	1 Gold, 1 Silver
