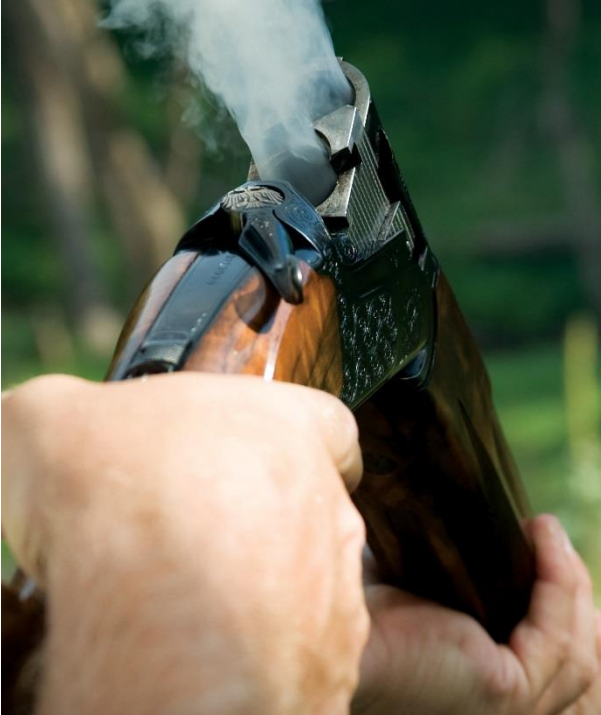

GOAL of the Sporting Clays Classic

About the Sporting Clays Classic

The Shooting Sports Classic is comprised of two flights of shooting activities. One flight is the sporting clays course, where shooters will visit various stations and shoot at different paths of clay pigeons. The other flight consists of shooting games.

From I-90 or points south: take the Elgin, Rte. 25 exit & turn right (north) onto Rte. 25. Go past the first traffic light north of I-90 and turn left onto a gravel road (Sunset Dr.). Immediately before the turn off Rte. 25, you will see a yellow junction sign for Albert Dr. on the right. Sunset Dr. is directly opposite Albert Dr.. Sunset Dr. is 0.6 miles north of the main Foundation entrance.

From the north: from the junction of Routes 25 and 72, south on 25 turn right onto a gravel drive just after a small house (Sunset Dr.). Immediately before the turn off Rte. 25, you will see a yellow junction sign for Albert Dr. on the right. Sunset Dr. is directly opposite Albert Dr.

Once on Sunset Dr.: bear left at the first fork and then almost immediately right.

Registration: The starting station will be assigned at registration.

Tournament Assembly: All shooters should assemble for check-in and a safety briefing.

Mulligans: Individual two shot "Mulligans" available at registration for \$20

Ammunition: Ammunition will be provided on the shooting sports course for **12 gauge** and **20 gauge** shotguns.

Gun Rental: A limited number of shotguns can be rented for sportsmen that do not have their own.

Shooting Safety: All shooters are required to wear eye and ear protection on the course.

Benefits received from the Shooting Sports Classic have an estimated value of \$85.00 per person. Contribution amounts that exceed the fair market value of goods and services received may be tax deductible. All proceeds from the event benefit the Three Fires Council, a 501(c) 3 organization.
