

LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE

The following policies can be found in *The Guide To Safe Scouting*:

- **Leadership structure: boy and girl dens are separate and have separate leadership.**
- **Units serving girls: must have at least one registered female leader over 21 in every unit serving females. A registered female adult leader over 21 must be present for any activity involving female youth.**

LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE (Con't)

- **Girl dens, troops, crews or ships**
 - Registered leaders may be all female or combination male and female.
 - At least two registered leaders must be 21 years of age or over.
 - At least one leader must be female.
 - A registered female leader needs to be present for all meetings , activities, etc.
- **Family packs**
 - Leaders may be all female or a combination of male and female.
 - At least two registered leaders must be 21 years of age or over.
 - At least one leader must be female.
 - A registered female leader needs to be present for all meetings, activities, etc.

LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE (Con't)

- Family packs & all girl packs
 - A registered female leader needs to be present (in the room) for all Den Meetings, Pack Meetings, and activities. *In the building or down the hall is not sufficient to meet this leadership guideline.*
 - It is a best practice that each girl Den have a registered adult female leader specific to that Den.
