

Cub Scout Winter Camping Policy

According to the Age-Appropriate Guidelines for Scouting Activities Chart in the Guide to Safe Scouting, Cub Scouts may not tent camp in the winter. National BSA has left it up to the each council to provide more specific guidance.

The TFC Camping Committee has established the following Cub Scout Winter Camping Policy:

Cub Scouts, including Webelos Scouts, may not tent camp from December 1st through March 1st of any calendar year. Furthermore, they may not tent camp outside of these dates when the ambient outside air temperature or wind-chill is forecast to be 35 degrees Fahrenheit or less.

Cub Scout winter camping in heated quarters is authorized if Guide to Safe Scouting leadership requirements are met.
