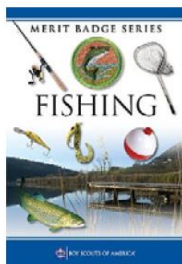
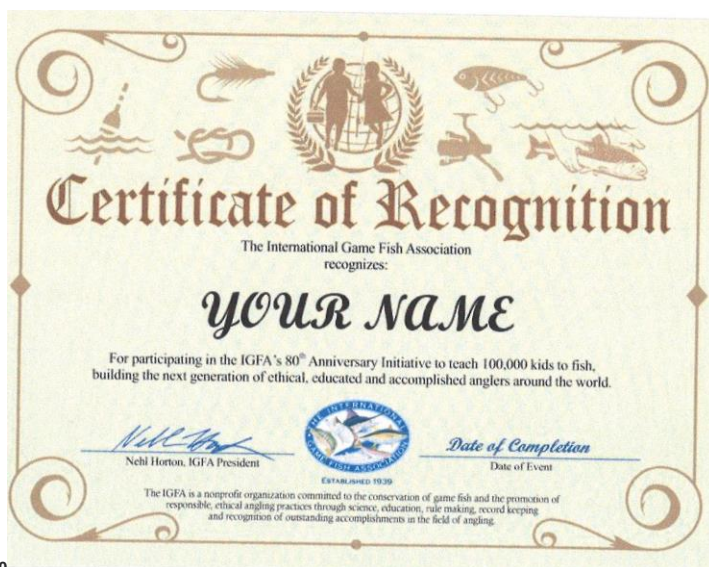


Partnership Between Scouts BSA and ICF

Directions for Scouts who have earned fishing-related awards:

3. Complete a short survey.
4. Get your certificate.
