



2020 Popcorn Sale 2020 COVID – 19 Guidelines

The health and safety of our Scouts, volunteers, families, and customers is our chief concern while selling popcorn this fall. We believe if your families and units make good decisions and follow some guidelines your unit will have a successful popcorn sale. Families and units should adhere to state and local health department and CDC guidelines. All those involved in selling popcorn should complete the simple health assessment before selling each time this fall.

Storefront Sales

- Have appropriate masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, sanitizer wipes for all manning the sale booth and for the safety of the customers
- It is recommended to tape off 2 areas at each table, 6 ft apart, for patrons to stand during purchases
 - ◆ Ask others interested to wait at a distance until a purchase area is open
- Only Consumer touches product
 - ◆ Do not have as much product displayed as in the past
 - ◆ Sell from cases only
 - ◆ Let the consumer pull their product from case
 - ◆ If unit pulls, ensure hand sanitizer is used
- Use a laminated order form that must be sanitized after customer handling
- Ensure Scouts do not block store entrances and exits
- Ensure Scouts do not approach customers within 6 feet
- Do not supply bags (if re-used bags)
- Display signage clearly stating safety guidelines being used
- Adhere to any of the stores additional guidelines not listed

Door to Door Sales

- Keep 6 ft distance between Scout and customer at the door
- Scouts should wear a mask while selling door to door
- Use the door hangers directing customers to your online sales if they are not home or if the Scout prefers to not have contact with the customers in the neighborhood
- Use a laminated order form that must be sanitized after customer handling

Home Distribution

- Provide an option for your families to do “curbside pickup” or contactless pick up – have the product on your porch or leave the garage door open and have the families sign for the product and leave the form
- Where a mask if you want to be with the families when they pick up product

Council Distributions

- Where a mask to council distributions to pick up product
- Units will need to load product into vehicles wherever possible
- All distribution volunteers will complete a health assessment

Health Assessment

Health assessment should be completed by an adult for every scout and for themselves before selling popcorn. Health assessments should be recorded and reported to the unit kernel for tracking. Here are the questions to be asked.

1. Have you tested positive for Covid-19?
2. Have you had close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 in the last 14 days?
3. Do you have a temperature over 100 degrees?
4. Do you have a sore throat or cough?
5. Do you have shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing?
6. Have you experienced any loss of taste or smell in the last 14 days?
7. Have you experienced unexplained muscle fatigue or chills in the last 14 days?
8. Have you traveled on a plane, cruise ship, or to a Covid-19 hot spot in the last 14 days?
