To qualify for the POLAR BEAR Award, the unit or individual must complete the following requirements:

- 1. The campout must take place between November 1st and March 31st.
- 2. Unit must provide appropriate training for cold weather camping prior to campout.
- 3. Camping must take place under a tent or an improvised shelter (NO CABINS).
- 4. All meals must be cooked over a wood or charcoal fire.
- 5. Duration of camp stay must be 24 hours or more.
- 6. Temperature must reach 32 degrees or lower during the campout period.
- 7. For all this wonderful fun, they earn the POLAR BEAR patch, which may be purchased at the Norris Scout Shop.
