Initiate Eagle Scout Board of Review Under Disputed Circumstances

If Unit Leader or Committee Chair does not

- sign Eagle application;
- Scoutmaster conference is denied; or
- sign final approval for project

Unit sends the Eagle application and a letter to the Scout explaining the reasons for the denial and the right to request a board of review under disputed circumstances along with the procedure on how to request a review

If Scout of parent/guardian has legitimate concern that unit will not provide a fair hearing

Submittal to Council

- (a) Letter requesting board of review
(letter sent to council office, attention TFC Advancement Committee Chair)
- (b) Completed Eagle application
- (c) Eagle project workbook

Council Advancement Committee Review

Request denied (rarely) and return to unit. Key is all Eagle candidates can request and have a board of review.
