



Eagle Board of Review Under Disputed Circumstances

Initiate Eagle Scout Board of Review Under Disputed Circumstances
Guide to Advancement Section 8.0.3.2

Unit Leader or Committee Chair does not
 - sign Eagle application
 - agree to hold a Scoutmaster conference
 - sign final approval for project

If Scout or parent/guardian has legitimate concern that unit will not provide a fair hearing

Submittal to Council
 (a) Letter requesting board of review by Scout or the Scout's parent or guardian
(letter sent to council office, attention TFC Advancement Committee Chair)
 (b) Completed Eagle application (sent to Council Office)
 (c) Eagle project workbook (sent to Council Office)

Council Advancement Committee notifies the unit leader or committee chair that the request has been received

Council Advancement Committee Review

Request denied (rarely) and return to unit. Key is all Eagle candidates can request and have a board of review.
